

# Comprehensive Developmental Evaluation



Using an inter-disciplinary team approach, The Child Development Team has created a unique evaluation designed for toddlers and pre-school aged children.

The 'Early Years Evaluation' helps parents and educators better understand the child's strengths and areas for growth.

The lead psychologist will determine the appropriate tests needed, and which CDT team members (speech and language therapist, occupational therapist, paediatrician) are required to be involved in the assessment based on the child's needs.

We work closely with parents and educators to ensure that the child is getting the most out of our assessment. Our team of psychologists are experienced professionals who are fully qualified and licensed in their country of training.

## Components of the assessment:

- Cognitive development
- Executive functioning
- Social and emotional development
- Language and literacy development
- Creative development
- Motor development

## How do I know if my child needs an assessment?

- They are of pre-school age (five years and under)
- There are concerns related to developmental milestones
- There is a lack of language development or acquisition
- There are concerns with expressive language delay (expressive language is how we communicate our needs with others using words or gestures)
- There has been a referral from school to guide accommodations
- To better understand the child's learning or development needs
- The child shows signs of exceptionalism or giftedness

# What is included in the assessment?

We conduct evaluations in the mornings to ensure we are assessing the child's true ability and potential.
